We are proud to share news of HNC Living Foundation's successes in 2021. We continued to achieve great things alongside continued challenges related to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

As you will learn through Charlie's story (page 3), each patient's journey is arduous and complicated. For people with head and neck cancer diagnoses, the challenges can seem never-ending. During 2020 lockdowns, many services and treatments our clients needed were unavailable. Challenges continued throughout 2021 as hospitals and care providers faced rising costs, staff shortages, and needs for more intensive patient care. The added uncertainties complicate HNC Living Foundation's clients' already-heavy burdens.

Thanks to you, our clients find hope. Your support of HNC Living Foundation provides resources that empower people to live life fully throughout their head and neck cancer treatment and recovery.

The celebrated return of signature events — MASKS for AID and our Annual Golf Invitational — raised more than \$350,000 in much-needed funding to help our clients. MASKS for AID was presented virtually in April to over 300 viewers and continues to reach more. The program featured Melinda's journey from diagnosis to receiving

dentures through HNC Living Foundation's partnership with Delta Dental; plus the debut musical performance of "Keep Me Alive," by Kaden, HNC Living's youngest patient ever.

Melinda now works at HNC Living Foundation, assisting with patient grant counseling and follow-up. "Keep Me Alive" has surpassed 60,000 streams and Kaden's music career is growing exponentially. CHARLIE

Too many head and neck cancer patients face financial challenges that are as overwhelming as the cancer itself. Expenses related to medical treatments, therapies, prescriptions, and co-pays often exceed insurance limits —putting a strain on household budgets and relationships. The Martin family knows this struggle well. Charlie and Sheila were in the throes of raising four young children, ranging from 2 to 8, when Charlie was diagnosed with throat cancer.

Rehabilitation and regular follow-up care are key to recovery and long-term health. The Martins' means to afford essential quality-of-life treatments and therapies became limited. As the miles traveling to appointments accumulated on their older minivan, transportation costs took a toll. Sheila began looking for options beyond crowdfunding and handouts. She found HNC Living Foundation through a desperate Google search. The Foundation provided gasoline cards to cover dozens of trips. "Without the cards," Sheila said, "I am sure we would have missed critical radiation appointments."

Beyond the logistical strain of dealing with head and neck cancer, the disease often affects breathing, eating, drinking, speaking, and the voice. Charlie is nearing completion of radiation treatments and Sheila reports that he is "getting a little better and a little bit stronger" each day. The Martins are forever grateful.

"This Foundation helped bring a little peace and less stress during a very sad, traumatic time in our lives," said Sheila. "I hope to one day soon donate to your Foundation and help others the way you all helped my husband and family."

Dr. Michael Dix, a longtime friend and supporter of HNC Living Foundation, is the dentist who helped lead our founder Teresa Walsh to the right specialists to uncover her cancer diagnosis. Dr. Dix has been a valued member of our community and has served on HNC Living Foundation's Grant Review Committee since its inception.




